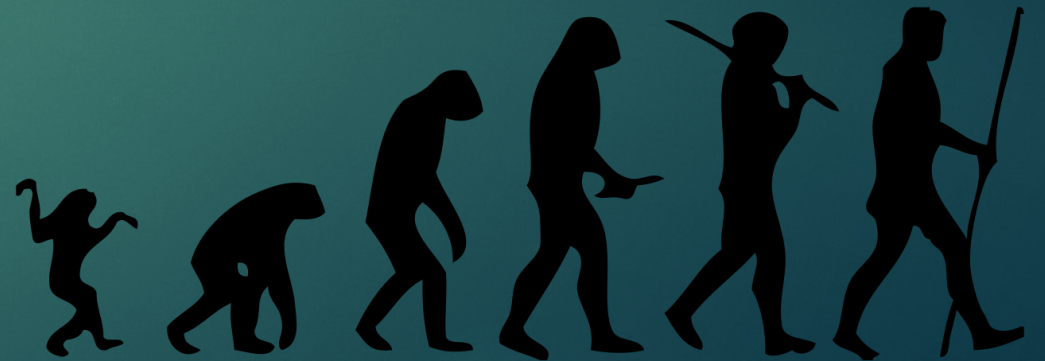

# Principles of Evolution

## ► General lines of evidence:

1. Fossil record
2. Molecular clocks
3. Anatomical comparisons
4. Genetics

## ► General principles:

1. Variation
2. Heritability
3. Competitive survival
4. Natural selection

# The Ash'arite School

## ► Occasionalism

1. Physical causality is contingent
2. Creation has no autonomy
3. God has total knowledge of everything

## ► Theological Voluntarism / Divine Command Theory

1. Good and bad are divinely decreed
2. God abides by no moral law



# 1. The Problem of Evil

- ▶ God is creator of everything
- ▶ Good and evil are from God
- ▶ Morality is contingent
- ▶ God could have created a different moral order
  - ▶ Programmer analogy

## 2. The Problem of Inefficiency

▶ Inefficiency implies deficiency:

1. Space
2. Time
3. Material

▶ God doesn't have a limit



# 3. The Problem of Chance

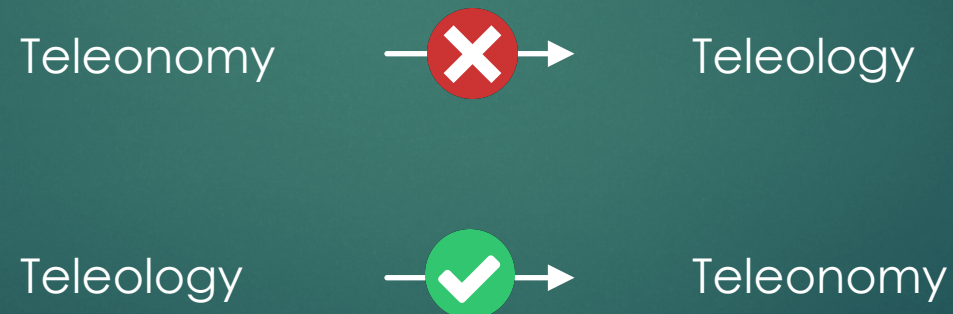
► Predictability - there are four kinds of chance:

1. Unknown cause
2. Unknowable cause
3. No physical cause
4. God-doesn't-know cause

# 3. The Problem of Chance

► Purpose – two kinds of purposes in nature:

1. Teleonomy (proximate)
2. Teleology (ultimate)





# Conclusion

- ▶ Compatibility is possible
- ▶ Provided it is maintained:
  1. No autonomy exists out of God's power/control
