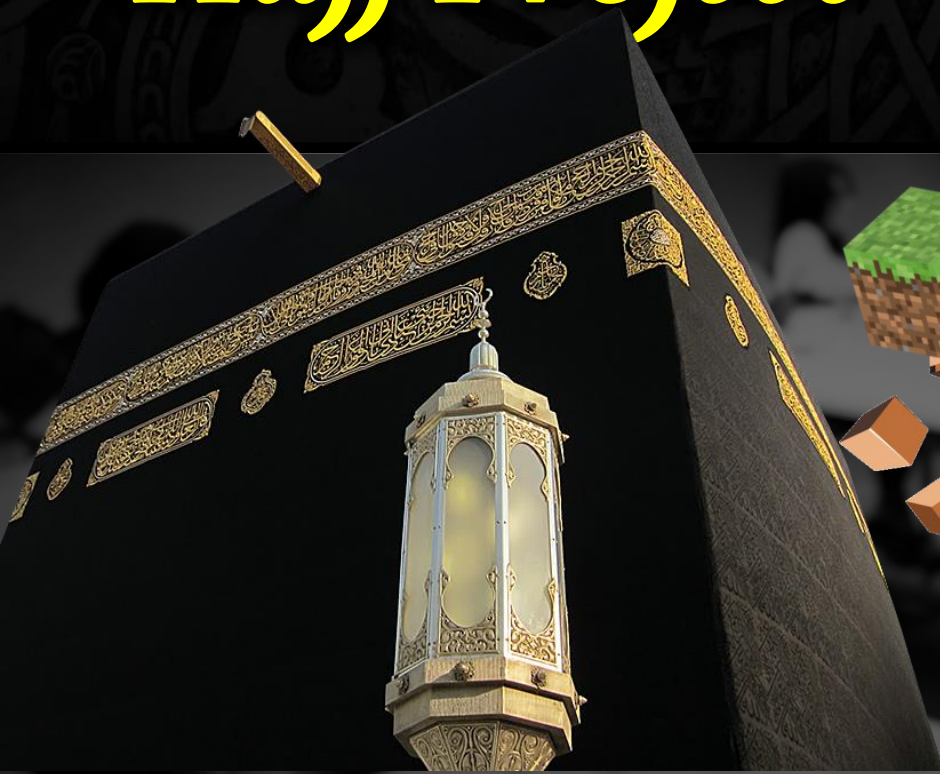

## The FEC Academy Minecraft Hajj Project

### Targets

- A. Get Steve to create a Hajj World for Minecraft
  - B. Research how Hajj is performed over the Five Days of Hajj – use all the information we have given you.
  - C. Do not miss anything out from the **'include'** list below
  - D. For the Hajj a Hajji goes to 5 LOCATIONS, which you must create:
    1. **Miqat** – The Start Point (Gate), where a Hajji wears the ihraam
    2. **The Kabah**
      - i. Near the Kabah you need to show the two hills called **Safa** and **Marwah**
      - ii. **The Well of Zam Zam** – near the Ka'bah
      - iii. **The Maqam of Ibrahim** – near the Ka'bah
    3. **Mina** – The City of Tents and the Three Jamarats
      1. Next to the tents you will also need to create the **Three Stone Jamarats**
      2. Also nearby a place where the sheep, goats, cows etc. are kept for the **sacrifice** (Eid al-Adha – Qurbani)
    4. **Arafat** – a small hill
    5. **Muzdalifa**
  - E. Once you've created the locations above. **Take Steve through the 5 Five days of Hajj journey.** You can either send us pictures of the 5 days of hajj or create a quick 3 minute video explaining Steve's Hajj Journey. Do them in the correct order, use keywords and don't miss anything out!
- HINT:** Remember all above locations are in the desert.  
**HINT:** Label all locations to make it easy for you to remember when making the video

## Five days of Hajj (Pilgrimage to the Ka'bah)

### 1. First Day of Hajj - 8th of Dhul Hijjah

***This day is known as Yaumut Tarwiyah.***

- The pilgrims put on **Ihram**.
- They declare the **Niyah (intention)** of performing the Hajj.
- They do **Tawaf (Walk around) Ka'bah** 7 times anti-clockwise
- Drink water of **Zamzam** from the well.
- They perform **Sa'i** (which means run between the hills of **Safa** and **Marwah**)
- They leave for **Mina** early in the morning, reciting **Talbiyah**.
- They stay overnight in **Mina**.



### 2. Second Day of Hajj - 9th of Dhul Hijjah

***This day is known as Yaumul Wuquf, or the Day of Standing.***

- The pilgrims go to '**Arafat**.
- They perform Zuhr Salah (Early Afternoon Prayers) and 'Asr Salah (Late Afternoon Prayers) together '**Arafat**.
- Pilgrims stand there with devotion, till sunset, **praying** and **asking Allah's forgiveness**. This is known as **Wuquf** or standing.
- In the evening the pilgrims go to **Muzdalifah** and offer shortened Maghrib Salah (Sunset Prayers) and 'Isha Salah (Night Prayers) prayer together.
- They rest there at the night, and collect **small pebbles** for stoning the **Jimar** (3 stone pillars which represent the shaytan) in **Mina**.

### 3. Third day of Hajj – 10th of Dhul Hijjah

***This is called Yaumun Nahr, the day of sacrifice.***

- They go to **Mina** and **throw small pebbles** or **stones** the large Jamratul 'Aqaba (Stone pillar Symbolizing Shaytan situated in the back).
- After stoning, they offer sacrifice.
- They return to Makkah and perform the Tawaf (if they have not performed the Sa'i on 8th of Dhul Hijjah, then perform the Sa'i also). **Then return to Mina and make sacrifice by slaughtering the animal.**
- They trim the hair or **shave the head**.



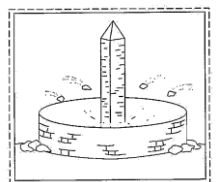
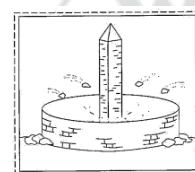
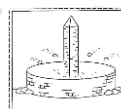
### 4. Fourth day of Hajj – 11th Dhul Hijjah

***This and the next two days are called Ayyamut Tashriq, which literally means the days of the drying of meat.***

- The pilgrims stay at **Mina**
- They throw pebbles at all three **Jimar (pillars)**.

### 5. Fifth Day – 12th of Dhul Hijjah

- Stay at Mina and throw pebbles at **all 3 Jimar (Pillars)**.
- Return the same day to Makkah
- Perform **Tawaf Ka'bah**.
- Drink water of **Zamzam**.
