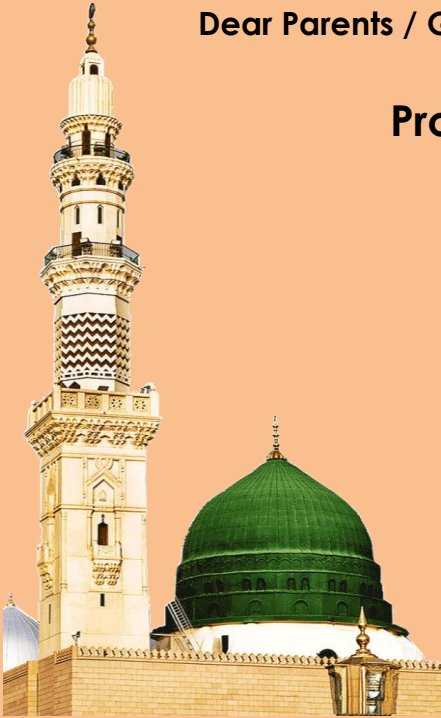



Students MUST NOT choose the same project as last year

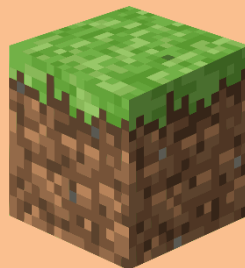
There is a lot of Information to help you available on our Website's PROJECT PAGE however it is your job to research and find out more (Parents to work together with children in Lower Primary School):

Prophet's residence

- Make a replica of his house
- Think about: size, rooms, furniture etc
- How he ate and slept in his house
- His routine...
- Different duas he recited within the house (entering, leaving, eating, sleeping, using the toilet)
- The chores he performed

Thawb & Nalain

- Find out about prophet's clothes and shoes...
- Think about what they looked like....
- Make a miniature version of his shoe or clothes...
- Most important: Why he chose to wear such clothes and shoes...



Etiquettes

- How he spoke to others
- His body language
- His treatment and mannerisms towards others...

Prophet's favourite food

- Research what kind of food prophet liked...
- Choose one, and come up with a recipe....
- Make a presentation and share it.

Poem about the Prophet

- Write a poem about the prophet...
- It can be acrostic, alphabetical, rhyming, or even a narrative...

Diary entry

- Imagine you were able to spend a day with Prophet Mohammed... Write a diary entry...

- Remember to write about his personality, how he spoke to people, how he ate, spoke etc.

Journalist

- Imagine you are a journalist.... What kind of questions would you ask him? After doing your research, what do you think he might answer to them?

Alien visitor

- An Alien has landed from Mars... He has heard the name Prophet Mohammed a lot from certain humans who call themselves Muslims...
- Write a description of him, including his appearance, personality, his attitude towards others, especially non Muslim....

Environment/animals

- Make a **fact sheet** or create a **short booklet** about how Prophet Mohammed treated animals and environment around him.

A short e-book

- Write a Short Ebook about the Prophet – which we will upload onto our website



Minecraft

- In 'Creative Mode' create all or one of the following:
 - the house Prophet (SAW) in **Madinah** –
 - The Prophet (Saw)'s house in **Makkah** where he lived with Khadija (RA)
 - The Masjid of the Prophet in Madinah

Video the end result and explain it in your video. This video will then be shown during presentations.
